	<b>DISPOSABLE MASKS</b> One-day surgical type masks	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>REUSABLE MASKS</b> Reusable face mask/barrier	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>GLOVES</b> Touchflex/surgical gloves	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>HAND SANITIZER</b> Sanitizer with 60 percent alcohol	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>HAND SOAP</b> Antibacterial or non-antibacterial	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>INFRARED THERMOMETERS</b> Medical infrared thermometer that measures range 32°C to 42.5°C (or 89.6°F to 108.5°F)	<b>ONE PER 50 EMPLOYEES</b>
	<b>DISINFECTANT WIPES</b> 10 percent bleach (sodium hypochlorite) solution, or a hospital-grade disinfectant	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>PAPERTOWELS</b> Disposable hand towels for lavatories and kitchen/break areas	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
	<b>NO-TOUCH TRASH CANS</b> Disposal containers for hand towels, tissue, etc.	<b>MIN. 30-DAY SUPPLY</b>
