■ **Tennessee**

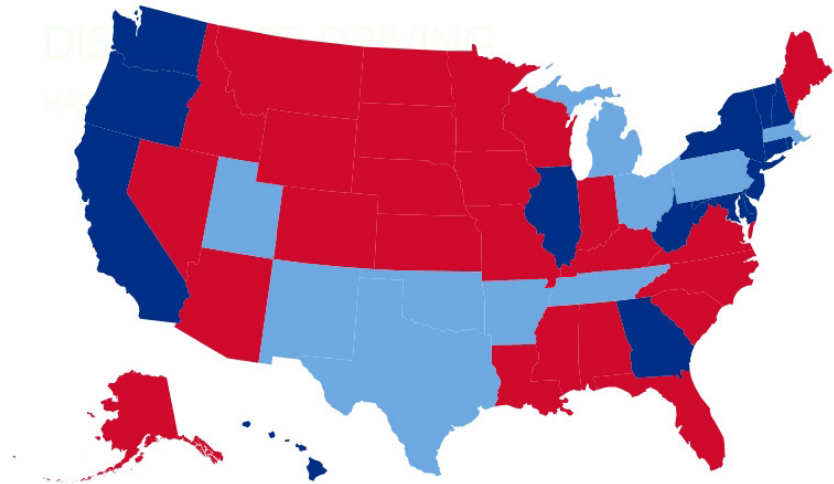
Drivers in marked school zones

■ **Utah**

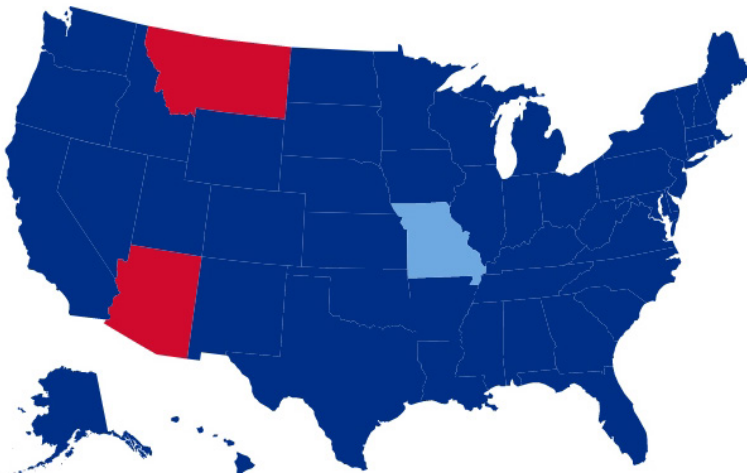
Drivers in violation of another traffic law
