The good news? Slips, trips and falls are usually preventable if proper care is followed.

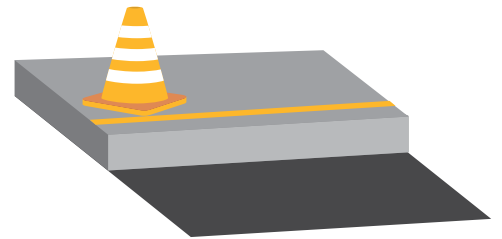
CHECK OUT THE TIPS BELOW TO KEEP YOUR WORKPLACE SAFE:
