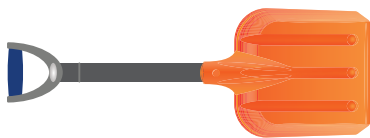


# WINTER DRIVING EMERGENCY KIT

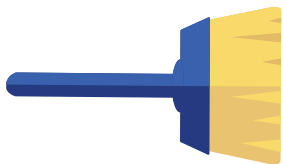


Driving in severe winter weather is dangerous, even for the most experienced drivers. In case of emergency, fleet drivers should keep a winter weather kit in their vehicle.

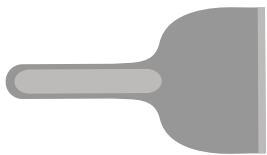

**SNOW SHOVEL**



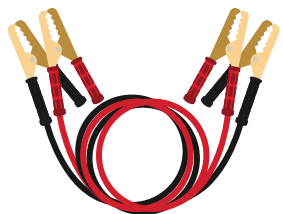

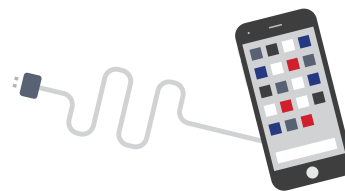

**WARNING DEVICES SUCH AS FLARES & EMERGENCY MARKERS**



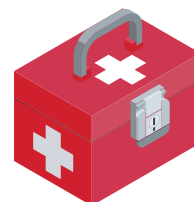
